Safety

Safety is important. Children should be encouraged to practice good safety habits. Safety instruction is given at school and safety measures are practiced in the building and on the playground. You can help your child develop good safety habits by providing safety instruction at home.

- ✓ Assist your child in learning the safest route to and from school.
- ✓ Encourage your child to use intersections when crossing the street rather than the middle of the block. Where crosswalks are provided, your child should stay between the lines.
- ✓ Encourage your child to come home immediately after school. Discourage any stops along the way home.
- ✓ Your child should obey traffic lights and look both ways before crossing the street.

Remind your child to:

- ✓ Never accept rides or gifts from strangers.
- ✓ Report to his/her teacher, a police officer, his/her bus driver, or you any strangers seen loitering on foot or in a car near schools, playgrounds etc.
- ✓ Always try to secure the license number of a car and write it down.
- ✓ Always try to remember what the Stranger looked like and how he/she was dressed.

PARENTING TIPS:

- ✓ Be a good role model at all times. Children learn from what they witness
- ✓ Model a clear sense of right and wrong by obeying laws from what they witness
- ✓ Show children that you care about people by modeling friendship with others, lending a hand to neighbors, or working with charity organizations
- ✓ Practice recycling at home. It demonstrates wise use of Earth's resources
